DESERT BIGHORN SHEEP

(two high fence enclosures 400 acres and 3,500 acres respectively). November through end of March.
4 tags available

Option 1 – Sheep only Package:

\$27,500 - This is a 4 day hunt in any of the sheep areas

Option 2 – Sheep and Coues Package:

\$29,500- Hunter receives a coues tag with the sheep tag. Coues may be hunted anywhere on the 65,000+ acre ranch. Hunter can hunt sheep in any of the sheep areas. This is a 7 to 10 day hunt.

Option 3 – Sheep Trophy Mule Deer Combo:

\$32,000 – Hunter receives a mule deer tag with the sheep tag. Mule deer may be hunted anywhere on the 65,000+ acre ranch. Hunter can hunt sheep in any of the sheep areas. This is a 7 to 10 day hunt.

The hunter will not be responsible for their food or transportation once they get to the Hermosillo. Hunter may fly into Hermosillo and we will arrange for transportation to the Ranch. A guide/driver (1X1) will be provided on all options.

DESERT MULE DEER

(both open range and high fence)

Option 1 – Basic Package & Deer Combo:

This is a January only option.

8 tags available

All hunters pay \$5,750. For that price you get 1 trophy Mule Deer, either a Coues Deer (trophy) or Mule Deer Management Buck tag and a Javalina. You can hunt anywhere on ranch. If you take a coues you owe a trophy fee of \$2,000. If you take a management buck (mule deer) you owe a harvest fee of \$1,500. Harvest fee on Javalina is \$200. Management bucks are deer 4 years of age or older with poor genetics for

breeding purposes. **Final decision on management buck is made by Cesar Carranza, Jim Worthan, or Steve Boero.**

There are no trophy fees for mule deer taken in the open areas of the ranch. Trophy fees on mule deer taken from within the San Jose Ranch (12,000 acres) are based on the following schedule (gross score): Less than 180 - \$2,000, 180 to 189 7/8 - \$2,500, 190 to 199 - 7/8 \$3,500, 200 and over - \$5,000. Cesar will provide a driver/guide at no additional cost for hunters who enter the San Jose Ranch. Trips to the San Jose are coordinated on a daily basis through ranch supervisor. Tips are your responsibility.

Hunters will choose from one of two hunting schedules: January 2 (arrive) through 10 or January 12 (arrive) through 20. There will be a maximum of 6 hunters in camp for either time period. Food and lodging costs are \$750 for the trip. You need to plan on having one member of your group drive a truck to the Ranch or rent a vehicle in Hermosillo.

Option 2 - Open Range Self Guided Trophy Mule Deer:

A January only rut hunt.

Limited tags*

\$5,250 allows you to harvest one desert mule deer. Each hunter on this option pays their share of groceries and camp costs (food, lodging, cooks wages, and ranch hand tips) for this season that cost will be an additional \$75 per day. You should plan on hunting with a friend and bring a vehicle (or rent) to the Ranch. This is a limited offer.

Option 3 - High Fence, Guided (over 12,000 acres):

This is a December only hunt.

3 tags available

\$5,750 plus \$1,000 kill fee for deer under 180 gross, \$2,500 trophy fee 180 to 189 7/8 gross, \$5,000 trophy fee 190 to 199 7/8 gross, \$7,500 trophy fee 200 to 215 gross, \$10,000 trophy fee for deer over 215 gross. Hunter will not be responsible for their food, lodging, or transportation once they get to the Ranch. Hunter may fly into Hermosillo and we will arrange for transportation to the Ranch. A guide/driver will be provided (1X1). The hunt will be for up to 8 days.

Option 4 - Management Buck (anywhere on ranch):

This is a January hunt.

3 tags available

\$3,500 for a management buck (only) tag. **Final decision on management buck is made by Cesar Carranza, Jim Worthan, or Steve Boero. If you shoot the wrong buck you pay regular mule deer prices plus trophy fee if in the San Jose portion of the ranch.** Each hunter on this option pays their share of groceries and camp costs (food, lodging, cooks wages, and ranch hand tips) for this season that cost will be an additional \$75 per day.

COUES DEER

(both open range and high fenced areas, over 65,000 acres):

Option 1 - For Coues Deer (only) Hunters non guided:

This is a January hunt.

3 tags available

\$2,500 for tag plus \$500 kill fee for bucks grossing under 100, \$1,000 trophy fee for bucks grossing 100 to 110, \$1,500 trophy fee for bucks grossing over 110. Hunter must have their own truck, (or hunt with someone who has a vehicle) for hunting the Ranch. Each hunter on this option pays their share of groceries and camp costs (food, lodging, cooks wages and ranch hand tips) for this season that cost will be an additional \$75 per day.

Option 2 – Coues Guided:

This is a December only hunt.

3 tags available

\$4,000 plus; \$1,000 trophy fee for any buck harvested. Hunter will not be responsible for their food, lodging, or transportation once they get to the Ranch. Hunter may fly into Hermosillo and we will arrange for transportation to the Ranch. A guide/driver will be provided. The hunt will be for up to 7 days.

JAVELINA (anywhere on ranch)

Limit for Season all hunters 4

Harvest at any hunters discretion, trophy fee \$300.

As a final note, hunters who drive their own vehicles to Mexico must get Mexican Insurance. We will refer you to a firm that sells the insurance on-line. It is fairly inexpensive. Additionally, if you drive to Mexico, we will meet you at a specified border crossing and assist you with the process, if you want the help. If you meet us on the day we are crossing there is no cost for the help, if we have to make a return trip to the border the cost is \$150. We will assist all hunters in getting their gun permits and other documentation (Cost \$300). You will also need a Passport.

Other Important Information for Mexico

The ranch will be open for guided deer hunts in December. This offers an opportunity to hunt prior to the rut when antlers are generally not broken from fighting. General deer hunting will start the 2nd of January and will be available until the season closes. Sheep hunting starts in November and runs until the end of March.

Deposits (all Bookings)

A 50% deposit is required to reserve a tag or date for a hunt. Hunt deposits are due by the end of June. Hunts will not be booked without deposit. Balance is due prior to December. Refunds will not be made on cancellations. You may however sell your tag(s) to a third party. Make checks out to Steve Boero/JFH and mail to JFH, P.O. Box 993926, Redding, CA 96099-3926.
